Introducing Milaidhoo Island Maldives

Opened in November 2016, Milaidhoo Island Maldives is a boutique luxury resort in the Baa Atoll UNESCO biosphere reserve, close to Hanifaru Bay, 126km north-west of the capital city, Malé.

Not just another five star resort in the Maldives, Milaidhoo likes to do things differently: the resort doesn't think of its guests as holidaymakers but as storywriters, crafting their dream holiday.

It's perfect for nature lovers as its own coral reef, which encircles the island, is a protected area and noted as an outstanding snorkelling and diving site in its own right. The tiny beautiful island, abundant with tropical greenery, measures just 300m by 180m and is fringed by white soft deep sand beaches.

Designed for couples, Milaidhoo welcomes guests aged nine and above.

Getting there: A 35-minute scenic seaplane flight from Malé International Airport brings guests directly to Milaidhoo.

Ba'theli Restaurant: perched on stilts over the lagoon, the signature restaurant is shaped like a traditional Maldivian sailing boat. It's the only Maldivian-cuisine restaurant in the Maldives, offering traditional islandinspired dishes intelligently reinterpreted for the 21st century. Open for dinner dailv

The Shoreline Grill: this beachfront grill is where guests enjoy fine cuts of meat, fresh local fish and seafood, simply cooked and beautifully presented. There's also a private chef's table and wine cellar here. Easy, simple, no fuss. Open for dinner daily.

Ocean Restaurant: diners sit outside on the deck overlooking the ocean where the style remains casually comfortable with international dishes perfectly presented. Here, the key words are fresh, flavourful and friendly. Open for breakfast, lunch and dinner.

Compass Pool Bar: a poolside menu of the freshest of fresh juices, infused waters, cocktails and light meals. Open from morning to late night.

Ba'theli Lounge: our over-water bar and lounge is shaped like a traditional Maldivian boat ready to sail into the sunset, where guests enjoy cocktails that are fresh, creative and on point. The wine list has been designed to pique the interest of wine lovers with a choice of much loved classics alongside a selection of wines from lesser-known boutique wine makers. Open every evening.

The Serenity Spa: four over-water treatment pavilions offer treatments using products from TheraNaka and Elemis.

Yoga: the resort's resident instructor leads complimentary group yoga and meditation classes at 7am daily except on Mondays.

Ocean Stories: diving (PADI eco dive) to over 40 dive sites; water-sports (kayaks, stand-up-paddle boards, windsurfing, catamarans); resident marine biologist; complimentary use of snorkel equipment; over-water infinity pool; 24-hour gym; excursions; fishing; indoor library/games room
